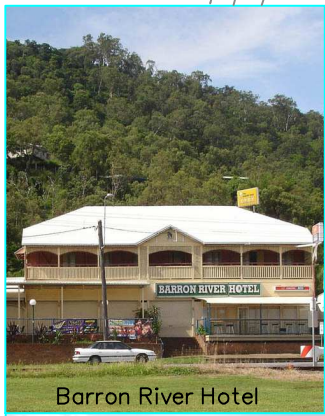
Stratford-Freshwater Heritage Circuit

- Distance:** 18 km (circuit)
- Time:** Cycling - 1 to 2 hours return,
- Start:** Flecker Botanic Gardens, Collins Ave

Heading east, take a left off Collins Ave into the creekside path that takes you through the bush to Quarry St and onto Aeroglen Drive. The road takes you past the old mill, sugarcane fields, Queenslander cottages and the charming Freshwater Connection railway station featuring a historic museum and theatrette (open every day) and tea room (open for breakfast 7.30am-10am).

At Freshwater roundabout you will find a popular swimming hole, also known as bana gamburra, a story-telling site to local Aboriginal people. Continue ahead and turn left into the cycle path before the skate path. Follow this path all the way across the creek to Glenoma park (another swimming spot) and cross under the tunnel where the path continues on the other side of the road.

Cross again under the next tunnel and continue on the path, and then again under the third tunnel. Roll down the hill and turn left off the bike path at the bottom to go up McManus St to the roundabout. Turn east into Woodward St and follow past Edge Hill village shops back to the Botanic Gardens.
